



# RE-CAR RETURNS

RE-CAR Racing will return to motor racing competition this weekend at Mallala Motorsport Park for the fifth round of the Fujitsu V8 Supercar Series.

Victorian Robert Jones has unveiled his freshly-painted Commodore VX in Re-Car colours and will have his first V8 Supercar race for the year at the South Australian venue.

Jones has been relegated to the sidelines for the first part of 2006 due to business commitments and injury (he broke his finger in a road bike accident).

Re-Car, a truck repair network, is a well-known name in motor racing circles. Back in the 80s, Allan Grice drove Commodores under the banner in the ATCC. Former driver and father of Robert, Bob Jones, acquired the Re-Car business in 2005.

The Mallala round of the Fujitsu V8 Series has 32 cars entered, but due to the track's small grid density, only 30 cars will be allowed to take the start of each race.

The support classes at Mallala include the Australian Formula Ford Championship, Historic Touring Cars, Performance Cars and Saloon Cars.
